




Poem to Share

Spotlight – Henry Niederegger



Born in Austria in 1933, Henry learned to work from a young age on his family's farm. Henry helped with farm work, in the saw mill and carting gravel. He continued his schooling and helped on the farm until he was 18 years old. Henry then started work at a factory which weaved material.

In 1955, Henry wanted to leave Austria, left on his own. Two friends were supposed to leave with him but when Henry arrived at the dock his friends were not there. He made the decision to board the boat alone and arrived in Australia in August just before he turned 22 in Bonegilla, Victoria.

Henry wanted to work on a farm and was soon selected to work on Nowrani Station Oaklands NSW, where the Simpson family had 20 acres of land and as many sheep. Henry enjoy being a farmhand.

Henry met his first wife Gisela on the neighbouring farm, where she and her parents and brother had worked. Henry and Gisela stayed at Nowrani station for approximately 4 years. While on Nowrani Station, daughters Wendy and Gabrielle were born. They left to come to Rutherglen where Henry found employment at the Rutherglen Research station. Daughters Monica and Karen where then born. The family shared their love of water skiing and horse riding. Henry also was a Glider pilot and loved taking to the sky.


Henry and Gisela purchased house with 14 acres in Ready St in the early 1960's and started a poultry farm. In 1970, Henry started work for Bunge Feeds as a Sales Representative and soon after the poultry were sold. In June of 1992, Gisela passed away from illness.

Henry met his second wife Irene in August 1992, while on his way to see customers in the King Valley. Irene was also widowed, after 2 years Henry married Irene. Henry and Irene bought a farm on Three Chain Rd and when Henry retired they continued to work the farm together.

Henry continued with his hobby of fox hunting and Irene became involved with assisting with Hunt breakfasts. Henry hunted until his last horse "Boris" died in September 2014.

At the end of 2019, the farm was sold and Henry and Irene moved into Rutherglen in January 2020. Henry has a great love for his wife and daughters.
